

International Travel with Children

Minor children (age 18 and under) traveling from the United States to any foreign destination, including Bermuda, the Bahamas, Mexico, and any Caribbean island, when not accompanied by both parents, must have a notarized affidavit from the parent NOT accompanying the child stating that:

1. The child is traveling out of the United States with the permission of this parent,
2. That the non-traveling parent is aware that the child is leaving on the departure date and,
3. The name(s) of the person(s) accompanying the child.

If the minor child is leaving the country without either of his or her parents, both parents must provide a notarized signed affidavit as outlined below.
